## NATIONAL SAFETY INITIATIVE -



From May 19<sup>th</sup> through June 1<sup>st</sup>, law enforcement officers across the country and throughout Vermont will be stepping up seat belt enforcement activities in support of the 2008 Click It or Ticket national enforcement mobilization.

Officers will be conducting seat belt checkpoints and zero tolerance seat belt enforcement statewide – day and night. This means that if you get stopped by a police officer and you aren't wearing a seatbelt – either as a driver or a passenger – you are going to get a ticket.

People may not realize this, but young people are more likely to die, or become disabled or disfigured from a car crash when they are teenagers, than at any other time in their lives. So remind everyone to buckle up, every trip, every time!
